Once you locate the desired footage; Click the scissor button to indicate the start and end of the clip.




Insert a flash drive into the DVR/NVR to store the footage.

Change the file format to MP4 (Universal format) Click BackUp.




Check the flash drive in a computer to make sure the footage saved.

Via Smart PSS Computer app


Log into Smart PSS computer app

Enter username and password


(If already logged in hit the plus sign at the top of the screen.)



On the main screen you will see the play back icon (looks like a movie reel)




Select camera, time and date & Hit search

Footage will be saved wherever path is selected


Via DMSS phone app

Select date; Then hit ok




Scroll to desired time




Use scissor button to start clip, play button to start playing from beginning of start point (you can drag to desired time no need to watch at played speed.) and stop button to end clip
